



The Nativity School Uniform Dress Code

REGULAR EVERYDAY UNIFORM:

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Girls: Skirts, skorts and jumpers are to be of modest length at all times. Please make hem adjustments for growth. NO shorter than 2" above the top of the knee.

Boys and Girls:

Shoes:

- Color Choices: solid black, navy, gray, white or red preferred (If shoes have a contrasting color piping, it should be minimal or inconspicuous.)
- Tie or velcro shoes with rubber soles are required for safety.
- Middle School (Gr. 6-8 only) may wear slip-on shoes of the correct school color (see above)
- Athletic shoes required for PE – all grades

Socks:

- Socks are required at all times for boys and girls with any style shoe. Color choices: white, navy, black. Please note that socks should be a solid color and a matching pair. Small logos may be permitted at our discretion. Socks should be long enough to show above the shoes.
- Girls may wear tights or knee socks (white, navy, black) - Peds/ultra-low socks are permitted for girls in grades 6-8.

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FULL DRESS UNIFORM: School Mass and other Special Occasions

Girls: Skirts, skorts, and jumpers are to be a modest length at all times. Please make hem adjustments for growth. NO shorter than 2" above the top of the knee.

Boys: Belts are mandatory, except for kindergarten

Boys and Girls:

Shoes: Bring a change of shoes for PE if your PE day is on a full dress uniform day .

OUTERWEAR:

- Purchased from [Land's End](#): Nativity jacket, sweatshirt, sweater or quilted vest with school emblem
- Purchased from [National Sports Apparel](#): Nativity sweatshirts or jackets
- Purchased from The Nativity PTG: Nativity sweatshirts
- No other outerwear may be worn (except for Friday Spirit Dress days), to include sweatshirts from previous years' field trip (camp, Washington D.C., etc.). ONLY Nativity outerwear is part of the uniform. (8th graders may wear class sweatshirt or high school sweatshirts in the spring after acceptances have been made and permission granted by the principal.)

HAIR:

- Hair must always be its natural color, worn neatly, clean and out of the eyes
- Boys' hair must be cut shorter than the top of the shirt collar
- Girls' hair adornments (bows, clips, headbands, ribbons, etc.) need to be of uniform plaid or solid navy, white, green, red. Holiday appropriate hair ribbons may be worn during that holiday season.
- No unusual or "fad" hairstyles or haircuts inappropriate for our learning environment.

JEWELRY AND OTHER ADORNMENTS:

- One religious medal, cross, or crucifix necklace or pin may be worn.
- Girls may wear one matched pair of stud/post pierced earrings.
- Rings, bracelets, or other types of jewelry may not be worn at school, including permanent jewelry.
- No tattoo, permanent or temporary, is allowed at school for any grade.
- Clear nail polish is appropriate. NO colored nail polish, gel polish, acrylic nails, or French manicure. Fingernails should be kept neat and at an appropriate length. If worn to school the student will remove it with polish remover under adult supervision.
- No make-up is appropriate for school. If worn to school the student will need to remove it under adult supervision.

Special Days

Tank tops, leggings, yoga pants, pajama pants, "short"/baggy shorts, sandals, slippers, slides are **NOT** allowed on **ANY** school day.

STUDENT MASSES - Every Thursday - Full Dress Uniform

- Dress neatly in full school uniform
- Shirts tucked in, appropriate dress shoes and socks
- Skirts and jumpers of appropriate length

Spirit Dress Fridays (privilege for all students who were in proper uniform Mon-Thu)

- Jeans, uniform bottoms, or grey Nativity sweats are permitted - Must not be ripped, torn, altered, or oversized.
- Any Nativity shirt (any Cultural Day / Student Life / Academic Decathlon / Track Meet / Nativity Team Shirt or uniform top / Middle School Retreat shirt)
- All students **MUST** wear appropriate uniform socks and athletic shoes
- Middle School Students may wear their PE uniforms



WOW! Wednesdays (will be one Wednesday per month) - Free Dress Days.

- Free Dress must always stay within the guidelines of modesty and be appropriate for school. In general, this means that free dress outfits should cover as much of the student as the standard uniform. The same rules for nail polish, nails, jewelry and makeup apply for free dress days.
- Shoes: free choice, but they must be appropriate and safe for play (rubber soled, no sandals, no slippers, no slides)
- Jeans or bottoms must not be ripped or torn.
- All students MUST have appropriate shoes for PE.

Field Trips

- Students must wear regular school uniforms for all field trips unless given permission by teacher and principal.

Grades 5-8 PE Uniform Requirements for Boys and Girls

- Athletic shoes (no sandals, slip-ons, casual tennis shoes, or casual Vans style shoes)
- Red Nativity Athletic Shorts (also used for team sports) that are mid-thigh length. If you are not part of a Nativity team you can purchase a pair of shorts on [Amazon](#).
- A "Nativity Athletics" t-shirt is a required part of the PE uniform to promote modesty, comfort, and personal hygiene. Every child entering grade 5 will receive one complimentary shirt, as will new students admitted into grades 6-8. Additional shirts may be purchased after school from the office for \$10. We suggest that you purchase three t-shirts to get you through the year.
- Students MUST wear the approved school PE uniform in grades 5-8 as part of their participation grade. Alternate athletic wear is NOT permitted.
