

What shoes should I wear inside the classroom?



In Kindergarten, we wear indoor shoes to help keep our classroom clean. The students complete work on the floor and we would like them to have a clean working environment to the best of our ability. All students need to have a black pair of indoor shoes. This would include moccasins, loafers, slippers, or ballet slippers/jazz shoes. The choice is up to your child's personal preference. When purchasing indoor shoes - please be aware that they need to have a bottom to them. (Leather/plastic, etc.) The reason, the indoor shoes need to have a bottom is that if there is a fire/fire drill students need to be able to walk the field. Students will also need to be able to take off and put on their shoes on their own.



(Please notice the full leather bottom, no ties, not a split sole. The full leather bottom is shown in pink for visual purposes only. All students need black indoor shoes)
